## Holiday

Brač offers an unspoiled environment with plenty to see on the island itself, plus boat trips to historic Split and other islands. Brač has a string of coarse sand and shingle beaches offering swimming in the sparkling Adriatic, and you can discover ruined monasteries up in the hills and bustling harbours like Supetar. An island gem!

## Hotel

The modern hotel offers 48 rooms, a pool, bar and breakfast room. It is quietly set within the wider Velaris Resort, where we eat dinner in the restaurant on 5 nights: menus feature organic produce grown by the hotel. Velaris has a small wellness centre (extra cost) and a private beach (with bar), which is a short walk through wooded grounds.

## Your room

The good-size double rooms are simply styled, with a balcony or terrace looking onto pretty gardens. Each has air-conditioning, a bath in the ensuite, a hairdryer and satellite TV. A room safe, mini-bar and internet access are all charged extra.

## Where & what

Velaris Resort is 15 minutes' walk around the headland from Supetar, on the island's north coast. Flights arrive into Split, from where we transfer to the ferry terminal for 50-minute crossing to Brač. Optional excursions include *Game of Thrones* filming locations, an island tour that combines scenery with sightseeing, or a ferry ride to discover Split on the mainland.
