

We pack so much into this short break in Northern Ireland, and there's something for everyone. Belfast city sights, the wild beauty of the Causeway Coast and *Game of Thrones* film locations, not to mention our own famous hospitality!

We include shuttle transfers from both Belfast airports and all travel within Northern Ireland.

Hotels

In Belfast, our base for the first night is the modern Premier Inn within the Titanic Quarter, the city's historic and creative hub. It's a short walk from the city centre and has a bar/lounge and restaurant.

The Marine Hotel is on the seafront in Ballycastle. It has 41 rooms, the friendly Marconi's Bar & Bistro and is your home for two nights while exploring Co Antrim.

Your rooms

Standard rooms in Belfast have a king-sized bed, tea & coffee tray and hairdryer. Recently-renovated rooms in Ballycastle are doubles or twins; hairdryer provided. Both hotels offer free WiFi in the rooms.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive by lunchtime to meet your Host at the Premier Inn. Check-in, relax and meet your fellow travellers. Free time for optional visit to the amazing Titanic Museum. Belfast's bar and restaurant scene is buzzing, so later we'll stroll into the city centre to choose a restaurant to suit our tastes and budget (dinner not included).

Day 2: This morning we include a Black Taxi tour of city sights, from street murals reflecting Belfast's past, to grand buildings like City Hall, Queen's University and the Cathedral Quarter. There's plenty to see before we leave for Ballycastle. After a warm welcome to the coast, relax over dinner in Marconi's.

Day 3: Today we lay on a tour of spectacular sights: the Carrick a Rede rope bridge slung 30 metres above the sea; the basalt columns of Giant's Causeway and two *Game of Thrones* locations. Ballintoy Harbour stood in for the House of Greyjoy's Iron Islands, and the ancient (and fragile) beech avenue known as The Dark Hedges was famously the King's Road. Transport included; it costs extra to cross the bridge or enter the Causeway visitor centre.

Tonight you may dine in the hotel or out on the town, at your own expense.

Day 4: We return you to Belfast for homeward travel.
